BELGIAN LAW OF JULY 8TH, 2018 REGARDING THE ORGANISATION OF A CENTRAL POINT OF CONTACT FOR BANK ACCOUNTS AND FINANCIAL CONTRACTS

Dear Partner,

We are writing to inform you that, in accordance with the Belgian law of July 8th, 2018, insurance undertakings operating in Belgium will now be required to send information regarding your customers who hold contracts with them to the Central Point of Contact (CPC), maintained by the National Bank of Belgium.

Within the next few days we will therefore be sending a letter to all of your clients who are Belgian residents, informing them about the new rules. Furthermore, we will be asking the customers, who have not yet sent us their tax mandate, to provide us with a duly signed tax mandate.

Additionally, we will be requesting that all customers who are natural persons provide us with their tax certificate (notice of assessment) and any other document confirming the compliance with their tax obligations with respect to the premium(s) paid on their contract.
